

How BoardMatch Montgomery Works – Nonprofits

- Nonprofit Executive Directors attend a 2.5 hour training designed to strengthen board practices.
 Nonprofit ED's are strongly encouraged to bring a board member to the training. Training is provided by Capacity Partners. Nonprofits may attend the training without participating in the matching process.
- 2. Leadership Montgomery recruits and trains prospective board candidates on the art of successfully serving on a nonprofit board. Candidate training parallels the nonprofit training, and includes:
 - Board Member Roles & Responsibilities
 - Best Practices of Sustainable Nonprofit Boards.
- 3. After completing the training, nonprofits interested in being matched with board member candidates complete an application.
- 4. Nonprofits are interviewed by the BoardMatch Montgomery committee. Nonprofit Executive Directors and Board Chair are both required to attend the interview.
- 5. The matching committee recommends candidate placements and makes introductions.
- 6. Candidates and nonprofits meet and determine to see if the match is a good fit.
- 7. Nonprofits submit candidates to the board nominating committee per their bylaws and report back to BoardMatch Montgomery on the candidate's election to the board.
