WHAT YOU NEED TO APPLY:

✓ REQUIRED:

- Interim Monthly or Quarterly Financials for Calendar Year 2020
OR Monthly or Quarterly Sales Tax Filings for Calendar Year 2020
- Articles of Incorporation or Articles of Organization

✓ AT LEAST **TWO (2)** of the following required documents that have been signed or have proof of electronic signature:

- Tax Return 2019 (or 990) – if filed
- Tax Return 2018 (or 990)
- Tax Return 2017 (or 990)
- Interim Financial Statements if applicant business is less than 2 years old
(and any Tax Return the business filed with the IRS)
- 2019 Profit and Loss Statement (if applicant business is less than 2 years old)
- Schedule C from your Personal Tax Returns (for Sole Proprietors) 2018
- Schedule C from your Personal Tax Returns (for Sole Proprietors) 2017
