## Child Care ReliefFund General Requirements

In order to apply:

- Childcare provider must be open •
- Have a Child Care Verification of Reopening form on file with their licensing specialist



## Child Care Relief Fund Document Requirements

As a grant applicant, you are also required to provide:

- W-9
- Maryland's Child Care Covid-19 Plan

# of Children enrolled – Enter the number of children who are enrolled in your program as of February 1, 2021, separated by age group

- Birth to 24 months
- 2 years to 4 years
- 5 years and older

# of Children no longer attending – Enter the number of vacancies as of February 1, 2021 by age group

- Birth to 24 months
- 2 years 4 years
- 5 years and older

## Child Care Relief Fund Tuition – Part I

- You must complete this information for each age group served. Do not include any discounts based on family size or income.
- If you charge monthly rates, divide the monthly tuition by 4.333 to determine the weekly rate
- Select Not Applicable (N/A) if you do not serve that age or do not collect tuition for that defined age group

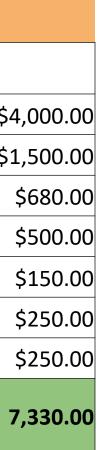
