Child Care Relief Fund General Requirements

In order to apply:

- Childcare provider must be open
- Have a Child Care Verification of Reopening form on file with their licensing specialist

Child Care Relief Fund Document Requirements

As a grant applicant, you are also required to provide:

- W-9
- Maryland's Child Care Covid-19 Plan

of Licensed slots: Enter the number of slots by age group, for which you are licensed

- Birth to 24 months
- 2 years – 4 years
- 5 years and older

of Children enrolled – Enter the number of children who are enrolled in your program as of February 1, 2021, separated by age group

- Birth to 24 months
- 2 years to 4 years
- 5 years and older

of Children no longer attending – Enter the number of vacancies as of February 1, 2021 by age group

- Birth to 24 months
- 2 years – 4 years
- 5 years and older
